MC Programmes - Complementary Masters

You already have an MA degree and want to gain a specialised professional qualification?

Complementary Masters (masters complémentaires or MC) are second-cycle university study programmes (MC programmes) which can be optionally pursued after completing initial studies worth at least 300 ECTS and culminating in an MA degree taken in two years. MC programmes correspond to a minimum of 60 ECTS, and can be gained after a minimum of one year of studying.

Where can I register? Registration for MC programmes is done at the universities belonging to the University Academy of Wallonia-Brussels.

What do I have to do? If you want to register for an MC programme organised by the University Academy of Wallonia-Brussels, you need to:

- Complete **the registration form**
- Compile an application file consisting of this registration form and the certificates mentioned therein, and send them to the appropriate Admissions Office.

After going through your application file and taking into account the **general admission requirements** foreseen in the 31 March 2004 decree of the French Community and any additional requirements set by the academic authorities (as found in the Academy's course catalogue), you will be informed by mail of the Admission Panel's decision. In the case of a positive reply, you will receive in the same mail payment details for the registration fees. On payment, you will be sent your student card.
